Terms & Conditions of Ticket Purchase and Event Attendance

German-New Zealand Chamber of Commerce Inc. (GNZCC)

Brad's Warehouse, Auckland

15 October 2026

These Terms & Conditions ("Terms") govern the purchase of tickets to, and attendance at, Oktoberfest 2026 ("the Event"), organised by the German-New Zealand Chamber of Commerce Inc. ("GNZCC", "the Chamber", "we", "us" or "our"). By purchasing a ticket, registering for, or attending the Event, you ("the Ticket Holder" or "you") agree to be bound by these Terms in full. If you do not agree to these Terms, please do not purchase a ticket or attend the Event.

I. Tickets and Entry

1. A valid ticket is required for entry to the Event and serves as proof of purchase.
2. Only one entry is valid per ticket purchased. Duplicated, altered, or falsified tickets will not be honoured and may be confiscated at the discretion of GNZCC or its representatives.
3. Tickets may not be re-sold or on-sold, by any means, at a price exceeding the original purchase price. GNZCC reserves the right to cancel any ticket it reasonably believes has been scalped or resold in breach of this clause, and to refuse entry to the holder of such a ticket, without liability to GNZCC.
4. Ticket transfers to another named individual are permitted up to 48 hours prior to the Event by emailing the event organiser (see Clause 24 for contact details). GNZCC accepts no responsibility for tickets lost, stolen, or transferred outside this process.
5. GNZCC and its representatives, including venue staff and security personnel, reserve the right to refuse entry to, or remove from the venue, any person at their reasonable discretion, including for reasons of intoxication, disorderly conduct, safety concerns, or failure to comply with venue or GNZCC requirements, without any obligation to provide a refund.
6. Where applicable, this ticket or its accompanying confirmation may serve as a receipt for the purposes of registration and payment.

II. Age, Alcohol and Conduct

7. This is a licensed event. Attendees must comply with all applicable New Zealand liquor licensing laws, including minimum age requirements for the purchase and consumption of alcohol. GNZCC and the venue reserve the right to request proof of age and to refuse service or entry where this cannot be provided.
8. Attendees are expected to behave responsibly and in a manner that does not endanger themselves or others. GNZCC reserves the right to remove any attendee from the venue for conduct it considers inappropriate, unsafe, or unlawful, without refund or compensation.
9. Attendees consume alcohol at their own risk and are responsible for arranging their own safe transport home. GNZCC strongly encourages attendees to plan for a sober driver, taxi, or rideshare in advance.

III. Limitation of Liability and Assumption of Risk

10. To the maximum extent permitted by law, GNZCC, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, sponsors, and agents ("the GNZCC Parties") exclude all liability for any loss, damage, injury, or death arising from or in connection with the Event, ticketing process, or attendance at the venue, whether arising from negligence or otherwise, except to the extent such liability cannot lawfully be excluded (including under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 or the Fair Trading Act 1986).
11. Attendance at the Event is at the attendee's own risk. This includes, without limitation, risks associated with crowded venues, food and beverage consumption, live entertainment, temporary structures, and general venue conditions.

12. GNZCC is not liable for the loss, theft, or damage of any personal property brought onto the venue premises by attendees.
13. GNZCC is not responsible for any act or omission of the venue, its owners or operators, security contractors, catering providers, performers, sponsors, or any other third party engaged in connection with the Event, and any claims relating to such third parties should be directed to them in the first instance.
14. Where the Event is cancelled, postponed, or materially GNZCC's liability is limited to, at its discretion, a credit, rescheduled entry, or a refund of the ticket price only. GNZCC is not liable for any incidental costs (such as travel or accommodation) incurred by attendees in connection with the Event.

IV. Photography, Video and Promotional Use

15. By purchasing a ticket to, registering for, or attending the Event, you acknowledge and agree that the Event may be photographed, filmed, and/or recorded, and that you may appear in such images, footage, or recordings as an attendee.
16. You grant GNZCC a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide licence to use, reproduce, edit, and publish such photographs, video, and recordings — including images in which you may be identifiable — for promotional, marketing, communications, reporting, and archival purposes. This may include use on GNZCC's website and social media channels, in event summaries and newsletters, in sponsor and partner materials, and in future marketing collateral for GNZCC events.

V. Privacy and Data

17. Personal information collected during ticket registration (such as name, email address, and payment details) is collected and handled by GNZCC in accordance with the Privacy Act 2020 (NZ) and, where applicable, GNZCC's privacy policy.
18. Where tickets are sold or processed through a third-party ticketing platform ("the Platform"), your information will also be subject to that Platform's own terms of service and privacy policy. You acknowledge that the Platform may process and store personal data on servers located outside New Zealand, and that data protection standards in those jurisdictions may differ from New Zealand law.
19. Personal information may be shared with GNZCC's event partners, sponsors, and service providers solely for the purposes of event coordination, communication, and delivery of the Event, and will not be sold to unrelated third parties.

VI. General

20. These Terms are governed by the laws of New Zealand, and any disputes arising from them or the Event are subject to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the New Zealand courts.
21. If any provision of these Terms is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.
22. GNZCC reserves the right to amend these Terms from time to time. The version in effect at the time of ticket purchase applies to that purchase.
